



Main Hall

The Main Hall is a large spacious room with wood flooring and has excellent natural light and acoustics. Measuring 45ft by 22ft. Equipped with a loop system for the hard of hearing and an electrically operated screen it is an ideal venue for meetings and talks. 80 people can be seated comfortably in this room or 100 people standing for private or social occasions. A licence can be obtained for the sale of alcohol which the Chair Person can apply for from Cotswold District Council.



Entrance Hall

The Entrance Hall is a smaller room measuring 15ft by 13ft. It is ideal for the serving of food and drink from the kitchen as it has a useful service hatch.



Kitchen

The modern kitchen measuring 12ft by 11ft has ample work surfaces and is in excellent condition. It is equipped with oven and hob, fridge, microwave, kettles, tea urn and has all the essential equipment necessary to serve or reheat simple refreshments brought onto the premises. Crockery and cutlery for up to 60 people is available. Hirers are required to remove all their refuse from the hall at the end of the period of hire.



Facilities & Equipment

The hall offers easy access and updated cloakroom facilities, including a separate disabled cloakroom with baby changing facilities. The hall is equipped with 66 stackable comfy chairs, 12 large and 10 small modern folding tables, plus a set of children's chairs and low level table. Additional seating is available if required. All rooms have coin operated wall mounted electric heaters. The Main Hall is fitted with a hearing aid loop system for the hard of hearing. Presentation equipment includes lectern, overhead projector, electrically operated screen, hand held mic, flipchart and regularly tuned piano. Free parking with ten off road spaces and one designated disabled space is available immediately outside the hall with additional parking on the street.

Hire of equipment off site

Folding tables, chairs, crockery and cutlery are available for hire for offsite use.

Groups and Clubs

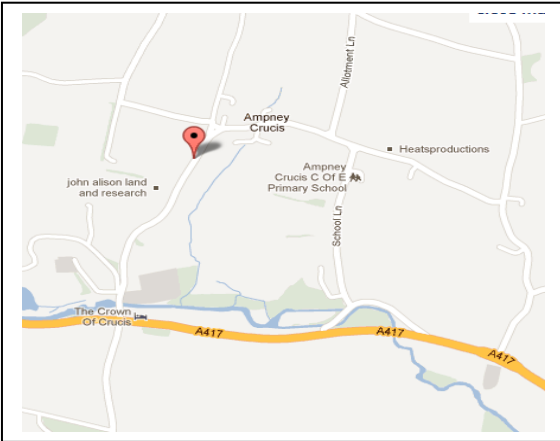
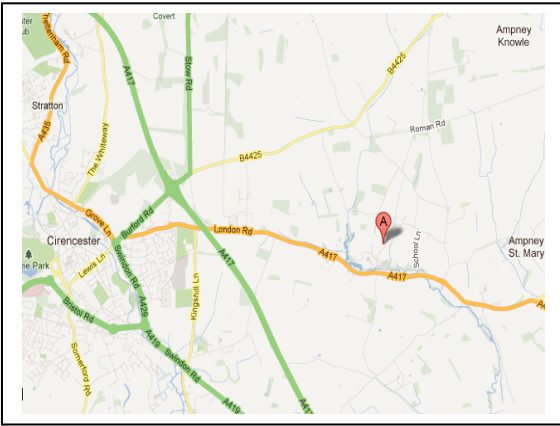
